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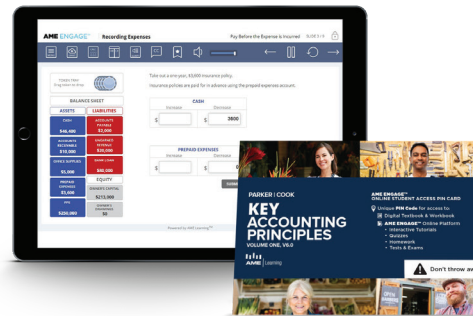
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Key Accounting Principles, V6.0 focuses on improving and updating the foundation of online learning materials and concepts with these new features:

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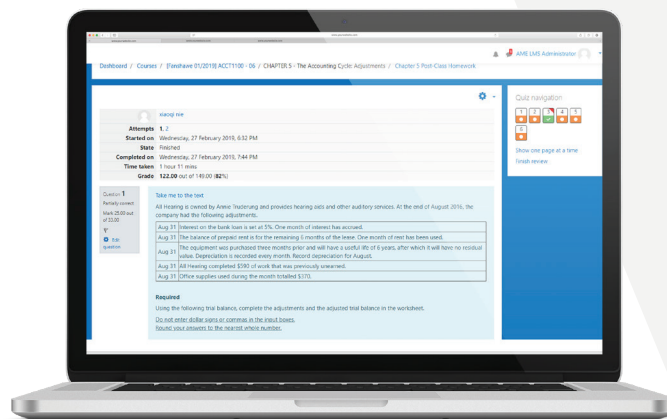
