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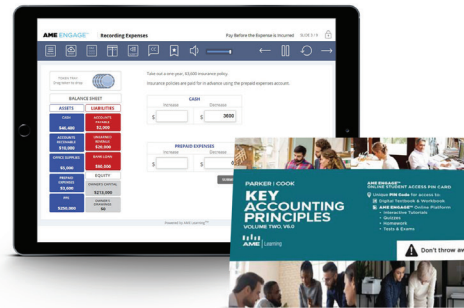
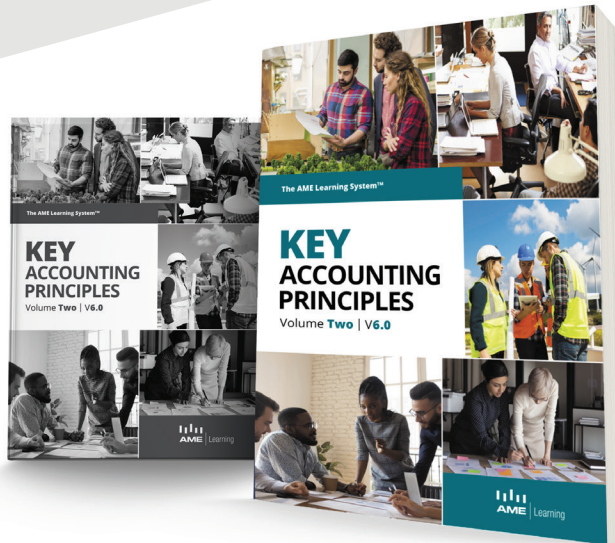
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Key Accounting Principles Volume 2, V6.0 has a renewed focus on improving and updating the foundation of online learning materials and concepts with these new features:

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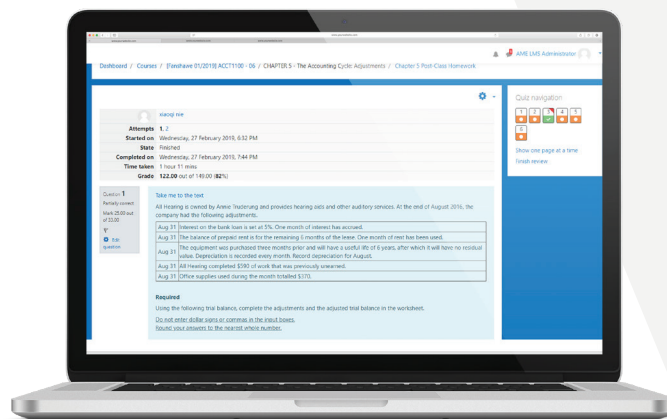
